OUR MISSION

YWCA of Greater Atlanta's mission is to eliminate racism, empower women, and promote peace, justice, freedom and dignity for all. Through the tax-deductible generosity of corporations, foundations and individuals, we achieve meaningful impact with programs focused on advocacy, social justice, health, safety, education, and economic empowerment for women, girls and their families. Our work is rewarding, extensive and expanding with our Being Stronger Together, the YW's effort to work hand and hand with our community, non-profit and corporate partners.

CORE PROGRAMS

Your contribution allows women and girls to participate in one, or more of our core programs:

EARLY LEARNING ACADEMY (ELA)

The ELA offers quality, affordable childcare and early educational experiences that stimulate and promote each child's cognitive, social, physical, and emotional development. The ELA program serves children ages six weeks through five years. The program provides services to 181 children and families annually.

ENCOREPLUS

ENCOREplus is a breast cancer awareness initiative focused on reducing the mortality and morbidity rate experienced by Black and Hispanic women who are medically underserved and underinsured. More than 800 women annually living in Metropolitan Atlanta benefit from early detection breast cancer awareness workshops and free mammography screenings.

DIGITAL SKILLS ACADEMY (DSA)

The DSA provides viable pathways for under-resourced women through digital and financial literacy and job placement support. This 8-week program features weekly classes taught by certified instructors in Microsoft Office and G Suite. The Digital Skills Academy (DSA) stands committed to the empowerment of women through our comprehensive programming. Our curriculum is centered on developing essential digital literacy, career readiness, and entrepreneurial skills. Within the DSA, participants receive steadfast support, rigorous training, and personalized coaching, leading to impressive outcomes: 84% of women successfully craft online resumes, 72% confidently submit job applications, and 41% achieve significant advancements in their careers. Actively addressing concerns of affordability, adoption, and access, we provide indispensable tools such as laptops, hotspots, and internet connectivity, complemented by tailored training to ensure each participant is well-prepared to excel in the digital age.

TEEN GIRLS IN TECHNOLOGY (TGI TECH)

The YWCA will relaunch TGI Tech in 2024 with a new pilot program featuring a revised curriculum. This in depth experiential learning program exposes under-served elementary, middle and high school girls from Title I public schools across Atlanta to STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts/Design, and Math) careers featuring college prep workshops, resume and job hunting preparation, mentorship and field trips.

GEORGIA WOMEN'S POLICY INSTITUTE (GWPI)

GWPI is the YWCA's statewide leadership, advocacy, and civicengagement program that brings together women from diverse backgrounds to develop and support statewide policy proposals that would improve the lives of women and girls. Women are trained and educated each year through the GWPI leadership program. More than 500,000 women and girls throughout the state are positively impacted by GWPI's efforts each year.
