

## YWCA of Greater Atlanta 2024 Policy Agenda

YWCA of Greater Atlanta will pursue priorities to improve the health and safety, advance the economic empowerment, and ensure reproductive justice and racial justice of women and girls in Georgia in the 2024 state legislative session.

The Georgia Women's Policy Institute, YWCA's signature advocacy training program, will focus on the following policy priorities this legislative session:

- Protecting working families by passing comprehensive and affordable paid family and medical leave for Georgians.
- Supporting healthy youth and young people by updating the comprehensive health and wellness curriculum in Georgia.

YWCA of Greater Atlanta will also collaborate with partners and other advocates on the following issues:

- Defending private-sector workers by enacting workplace anti-discrimination legislation.
- Striving for menstrual equity and addressing issues of period poverty in Georgia.
- Improving maternal health by supporting policies that improve the lives of pregnant and postpartum people.
- **Supporting and protecting survivors** of family and intimate partner violence.
- Ensuring Georgians have the right to bodily autonomy, and access to the comprehensive reproductive care of their choice.
- Ensuring individuals have the right to parent their children in safe and healthy environments by removing outdated restrictions related to Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) benefits.
- Allow for all Georgians to make a fair wage by phasing out subminimum wage practices.
